We are writing to introduce you to SuperDville, the Social Emotional Learning (SEL) curriculum we will use this year. The program utilizes videos, peer-to-peer learning, and skills-based activities to help students with learning differences get the extra social-emotional support they need.

As we move through the program, we will be working on building social skills and increasing self-esteem around schoolwork. This is important so that students can create a positive identity that will help them avoid developing anxiety or shame around their academic achievement by:

- Leveraging strengths to independently overcome challenges
- Navigating conflict in peer relationships
- Taking ownership of learning with self-advocacy strategies

You might see your child bring home worksheets and art projects with the SuperDville logo. We encourage you to talk about these projects with your child. You may find that they have new strategies and ways to talk about challenges they encounter with friends or in their academics!
